NTCAR names Caroline Rose Hunt, Mike Berry to Hall of Fame

Caroline Rose Hunt will be named to NTCAR's Hall of Fame in May.

The North Texas Commercial Association of Realtors (NTCAR) announced Monday it plans to name the Caroline Rose Hunt family and Mike Berry to its Hall of Fame in May.

The Hall of Fame honor recognizes game-changing professionals in the commercial real estate industry in North Texas. Other past recipients of the award include Trammell Crow, Henry S. Miller Jr. and John M. Stemmons Sr.

Both Mike Berry and Caroline Rose Hunt's family have brought worldwide acclaim to the North Texas region in their respective sectors of the industry, said Chris Teesdale, chair of the 2013 NTCAR Hall of Fame dinner.

That's why the two entities will receive the prestigious award, he said.

The Caroline Rose Hunt family built the Rosewood Corporation, which invests in real estate, oil and gas, private equity capital. It has three subsidiaries including, Rosewood Resources Inc., Rosewood Private Investments and Rosewood Property Co.

The family built the luxury Rosewood Hotel & Resort hotel management company.

Mike Berry is the president of Hillwood Properties, which has developed the 17,000-acre AllianceTexas development. The company recently brought in a 1.1-million-square-foot distribution center for Amazon.com.

The awards will be given at the organization's annual Hall of Fame dinner on Thursday, May 2 at Brook Hollow Golf Club.
