DALLAS (March 31, 2022) - HHM (Healing Hands Ministry) Health proudly presented the Healthcare Innovator Award to The Rosewood Foundation at their Healing Hands Luncheon on March 31, 2022 at the Dallas Arboretum. In 2020, The Rosewood Foundation helped establish a vision clinic at HHM Health. The Rosewood Foundation's Director, Lynn Fisher, and Trustee, Julia Sands Cunningham were on a site visit and spotted a donated ophthalmology chair. Less than a year later, that visit turned into a partnership that led to the creation of The Rosewood Vision Center at HHM Health. "A good reminder to always look for what's possible when paths cross and great organizations collaborate," said Lynn Fisher.

Since its inception, approximately 2,000 patients are seen annually to provide compassionate, quality vision healthcare. The center was made possible by a grant from The Rosewood Foundation, which was founded by the late Caroline Rose Hunt. Mrs. Hunt struggled with macular degeneration and was a passionate advocate for vision health. Julia Sands Cunningham, granddaughter of Caroline Rose Hunt, serves on the HMM Health's Advisory Council and accepted the award.
